The role of occupational medicine at CERN:

- ➔ To periodically examine the health of staff members and to carry out specific examinations when necessary, in order **to determine the aptitude** of a person to his or her job
- ➔ To ensure the **health and safety** of the personnel and their suitability to their working environment
- ➔ To **give first aid** to ill or injured persons on the CERN site (in collaboration with the Fire Brigade)
- ➔ To take suitable measures in preventive medicine and **hygiene** at work, as well as **ergonomics**, addictions, and a quality control of the CERN restaurants
- ➔ To follow up personnel on long term sick leave and following **professional accidents/diseases**

The Medical Service is sworn to professional secrecy!

Please do not hesitate to contact us in case of any professional or personal problem



CERN's Medical Service ensures:

- **Regular medical check-ups** for personnel according to their occupational hazards
- Medical consultations/vaccinations prior to **an assignment abroad**
- **First-aid and/or treatment** at the Infirmary for persons who are injured or ill
- **Periodical blood tests** depending on the hazards associated with the professional activity
- **Complementary medical examinations** : electrocardiogram, lung function test, eye test, audiogram, urine test as medically prescribed
- **Vaccinations** and their follow up
- Consultations for personal or work-related **psychological problems**
- Medical consultations **to help give up smoking**
- **Health promotion and prevention campaigns** :

Examples:

- Organising health campaigns and screening (hearing, cardio-vascular risks, diabetes, balanced nutrition, high blood pressure)
- Ergonomics information sessions and individual workplace visits

CERN's Medical Service does **not** ensure:

- The medical follow-up of chronic illnesses
- Medical consultations for pensioners or CERN workers' families (spouse or children)
- Medical consultations for bank loans or sports certificates
- Treatment for accidents having occurred outside the CERN site, but does offer advice on local Swiss or French healthcare facilities
